Instructions to candidates;

- 1. Please read and understand the instructions provided in the document titled "Instructions for Providing Answers" prior to the test.
- 2. Your Index Number for the Aptitude Test and the relevant Examination Centre is specified in the Admission Card.
 - You must bring a printed copy of the Admission Card to the examination Examination Centre.
 - You must bring your **National Identity Card** to the Examination Centre.
 - In case, the National ID Card is lost or stolen, you are required to bring one of the following identification documents to the examination centre.
 - Passport
 - Driving Licence
 - $\circ~$ A duly certified Photograph in the absence of any of the above identification documents.
 - No candidate will be admitted to the Examination Centre without the Admission Card and one of the above identification documents.
- **3.** Please ensure that you accurately write your Index Number in the designated space on the Answer Sheet during the Test.
- 4. It is important that you adhere to the following instructions during the test;
 - I. Candidates are required to be present at the Examination Centre **at least 01 hour before** the commencement of the Test.
 - II. Candidates will not be admitted to the Examination Hall **after the first half-an-hour of the examination**. Once admitted to the examination hall, candidates are not allowed to leave the examination hall till the examination is over.
 - III. Candidates must bring a good quality ballpoint pen to the Examination Centre
 - IV. Candidates are prohibited to have any electronic device with communication and/or storage capabilities such as mobile phone, calculator, tablet PC, laptop, smart watch, portable audio/video/gaming devices and etc. inside the examination halls irrespective of the fact that the above mentioned electronic devices are switched on or off.
 - V. Candidates are prohibited to possess any notes, formulae or any other unauthorised material with them during the examination. Books, handbags etc. which students have brought with him/her should be kept outside the Examination Hall.
 - VI. Candidates are under the authority of a Supervisor and Invigilators throughout the test and the candidates should adhere to their instructions during the test.
 - VII. After entering the hall, candidates should go to the seat assigned to them according to the order of index number and should not change the seat without the permission of the Supervisor.
 - VIII. Candidates should maintain absolute silence in the Examination hall and around it. Candidates should not speak or communicate with anyone other than the Supervisor/ Invigilator during the test. If a candidate needs to draw the attention of the Supervisor/Invigilator, he/ she should raise the hand.

- IX. Candidates are not allowed to leave the Examination hall even temporarily after starting the test. In case of an emergency, the Supervisor/ Invigilator will grant them permission under constant surveillance.
- X. All calculations and rough work should be done only on the sections given in the question paper. Candidates should not do any rough work on the admission cards or the answer sheet.
- XI. Candidates should stop answering immediately when the Supervisor/Invigilator orders.
- XII. Candidates should hand over the answer sheet personally to the Supervisor/Invigilator after the test and remain in their seat until it is collected.
- XIII. Candidates are not allowed to remove the answer sheet and/ or the question paper from the Examination hall.
- XIV. Candidates should adhere to the rules of the Examination. In case the supervisor of the examination has a reasonable doubt that a candidate has committed an examination offence, the candidate should furnish a written statement on the offence committed when requested by the Supervisor.

- The candidates should have fulfilled the requirements listed in section 2 and 2.2.8.26 of the Hand Book on "Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka - Academic Year 2022/2023" issued by the University Grants Commission.
- The candidates should indicate their preferred University/ Institute to be considered for the above Degree Programme in their applications for University Admissions for the academic year 2022/2023 submitted to the University Grants Commission.
- The candidates should note that passing the Aptitude Test alone does not guarantee your selection for the Information Systems Undergraduate Degree Programmes offered by the University of Colombo School of Computing, the Faculty of Computing of University of Sri Jayewardenepura or the Faculty of Computing of Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka.

The University of Colombo School of Computing or the University of Sri Jayewardenepura or the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka will not provide you with travelling or any other expenses for appearing for the Test.
